West From Baltimore:

Take I-70 West to Exit 32B (Hagerstown / Route 40), go three (3) stop lights (at Edgewood Drive, Mt. Aetna Road, and Eastern Blvd. ... approximately 2 miles), then turn right on Eastern Blvd. Follow Eastern Blvd. three (3) stop lights (at Route 64 / Jefferson Blvd., blinking light at Security Blvd. and light at Route 60 ... approximately 3 miles). At this point, continue going across Route 60 and the road name changes to Northern Avenue. Go through four (4) lights (at Hamilton Blvd., Oak Hill Avenue, Fountaindale Road and Lauran Road ... approximately .9 miles) and you will see a Western Maryland Hospital Center sign on the left. Make a left hand turn at the Western Maryland Hospital Center sign. Go up the driveway to the stop sign, turn right and park in any available parking space.

East From Cumberland:

Take I-70 East to I-81 North (Exit 26). Follow I-81 North to Exit 9 (Maugans Avenue), bear right on Maugans Avenue, go two (2) stop lights (at Mack Truck Road and Pennsylvania Avenue. Follow Pennsylvania Avenue four (4) lights (at North Pointe Drive, Club Road, Northern Avenue and Fairview Road ... approximately 1.5 miles). At the fourth light, you will see the Western Maryland Hospital Center to the left, turn at the driveway and park in any available parking space.

North From West Virginia:

Take I-81 North to Exit 9 (Maugans Avenue.), bear right on Maugans Avenue, go two (2) stop lights (at Mack Truck Road and Pennsylvania Avenue ... approximately .6 mile) then turn right on Pennsylvania Avenue. Following Pennsylvania Avenue four (4) lights (at North Pointe Drive, Club Road, Northern Avenue and Fairview Road ... approximately 1.5 miles). At the 4th light, you will see Western Maryland Hospital Center to the left, turn at the driveway and park in any available parking space.

South From Pennsylvania:

Take I-81 South to Exit 9 (Maugans Avenue.), turn left on Maugans Avenue, go two (2) stop lights (at Mack Truck Road and Pennsylvania Avenue ... approximately .6 mile) then turn right on Pennsylvania Avenue. Following Pennsylvania Avenue four (4) lights (at North Pointe Drive, Club Road, Northern Avenue and Fairview Road ... approximately 1.5 miles). At the 4th light, you will see Western Maryland Hospital Center to the left, turn at the driveway and park in any available parking space.
